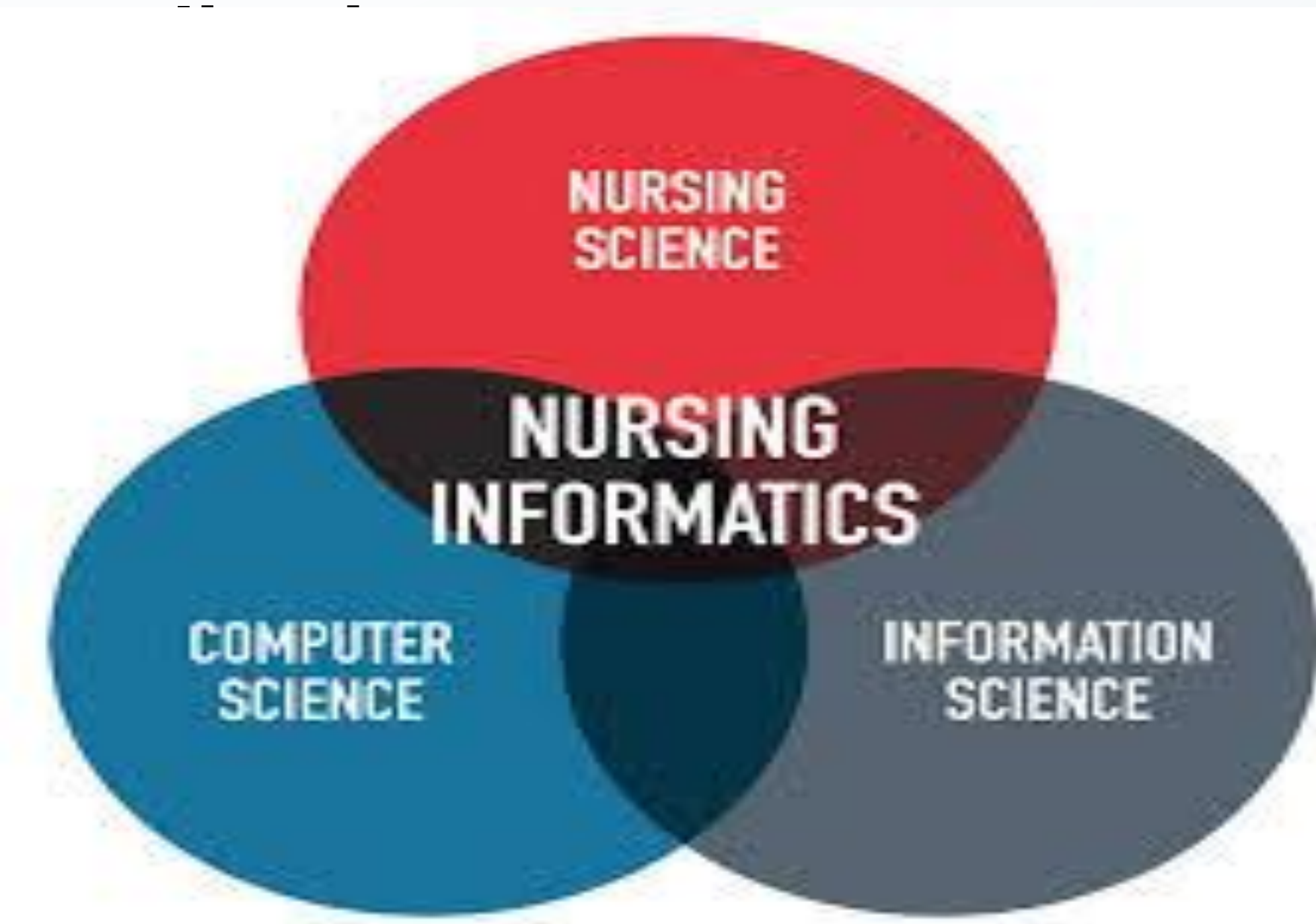
## Methodology
