


Organ damage in teens due to hypertension?!



Arterial Hypertension is the increase in systolic and diastolic blood pressure more than normal but did you know that its relevant in teens just as much as adults ????

| Blood Pressure(mmHg) | Systolic (Upper number) | | Diastolic (Lower number) |
|---|----------------------------|----------|--------------------------------------|
| Normal | Less than 120 | AND | Lower than 80 |
| Pre-Hypertension | 120-139 | OR | 80-89 |
| Hypertension(Stage1) | 140-159 | OR | 90-99 |
| Hypertension(Stage2) | 160 or greater | OR | 100 or greater |
| Hypertension Crisis (Needs Emergency Care) | Greater than 180 | OR OR | Greater than 110 End organ damage |
