

Tutors` Training Workshop

In order to ensure the quality of the all tutors to be employed in the faculty of pharmacy, and taking in consideration that the tutor is playing a very important role in the learning process and have many academic and administrative tasks therefore, the faculty organized a workshop to develop and evaluate the regular tutors and to train all the applicants for the tutor job at Faculty of Pharmacy for the academic year 2017/2018.

First Day Activities:

- The first day began at 10 am with a speech from the Faculty of Pharmacy Dean; Dr. Salma Bukhatwa who welcomed the trainees and all Faculty members who were invited to attend the first day of the workshop.
- Dr. Eman Elmahdi, Curriculum Committee Coordinator, presented an interactive lecture entitled "Teaching and Learning".
- Dr. Amna Bugrain; Chief Tutor, presented an interactive lecture entitled "introduction to PBL".
- After a coffee break, the participants watched a role play that was performed by the Faculty team to demonstrate how the brainstorming session are conducted.

Second day activities:

- The 2nd day began with a brainstorming session where the participants divided into two groups and two participants volunteered to play the role of tutor
- After a coffee break, Dr. Amna Bugrain presented an interactive lecture titled "How other sessions in PBL run".

Third day activities:

- The 3rd day began with an interactive lecture titled "How to be a good tutor"
