The vocal cords are located in the voice box(larynx), which is right below the throat(pharynx)., The medical term is laryngeal cancer. Because there are three types of laryngeal cancer: glottis 70%, supraglottic, and subglottic.

2. Symptoms

- Voice change.
- Chronic sore throat, sometimes with ear pain.
- Trouble swallowing with associated weight loss.
- Trouble breathing.
- Sensation of something stuck in the throat.
- The appearance of one or more lumps that can be felt in the neck.
- Coughing up of blood.

3. Causes

- Smoking 95%.
- Excessive alcohol consumption .
- The presence of a genetic factor and a previous family history of vocal cord cancer symptoms.
- Having an unhealthy diet low in fruit and vegetables.

4. How vocal cord is diagnosed

- A thorough evaluation of all the patient's symptoms.
- Imaging tests such as CT scans,
 PET Scan, x-rays, or MRI.
- Laryngoscopy (insertion of a small magnifying lens into the larynx to examine the vocal cords directly).
- Biopsy (removing a small sample of tissue for lab testing to determine the presence of cancer).



5. Treatment

- Surgery
- Radiation therapy,
- In-office laser treatments
- Chemotherapy,

The chemo drugs ARE:
Cisplatin, Carboplatin,
5_fluorouracil,
Docetaxel, Paclitaxel,
Methotrexate, Capecitabine, a
pill that is changed into-FU
once it gets to the tumor.
