Smoking Cigarette causes many diseases, and reduces the health of smokers in general :

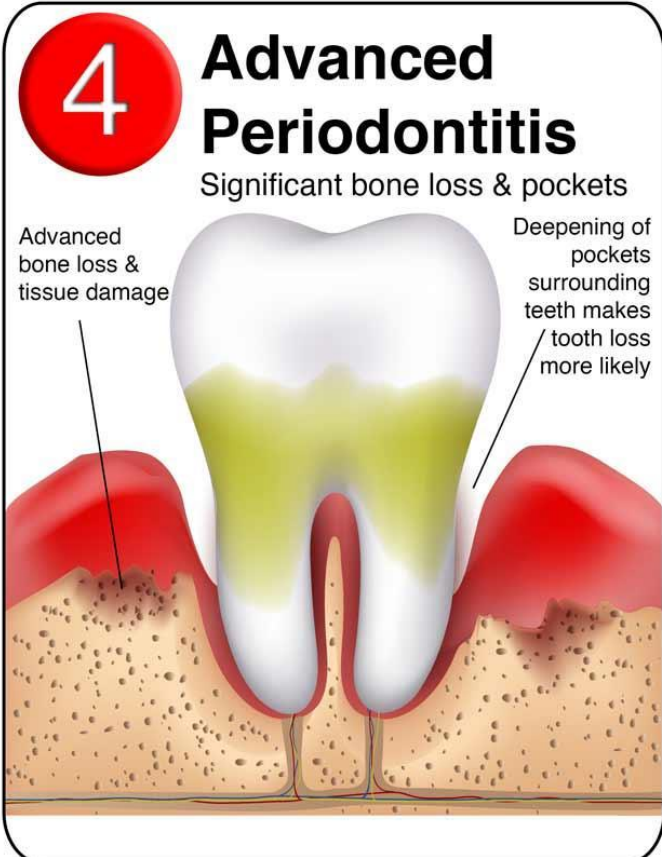
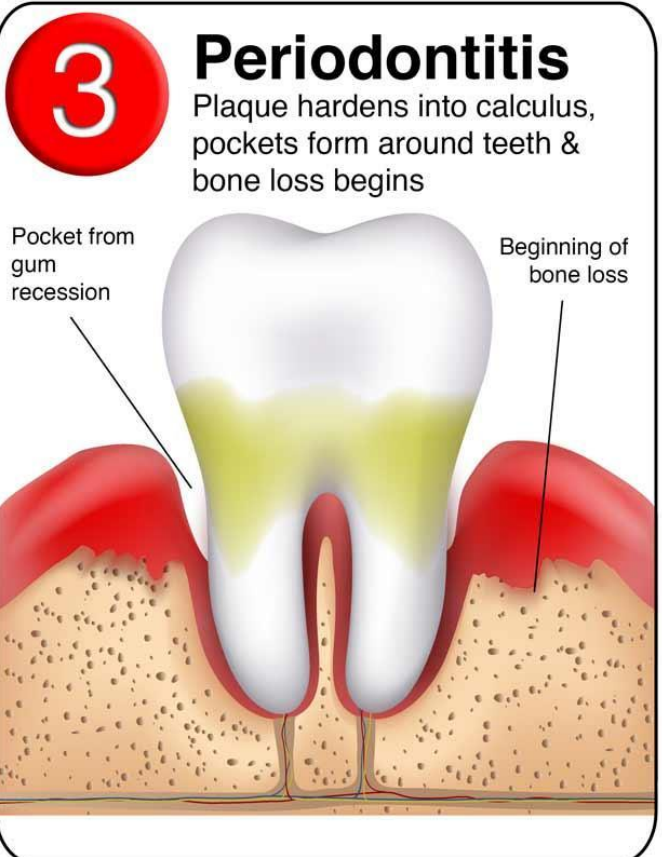
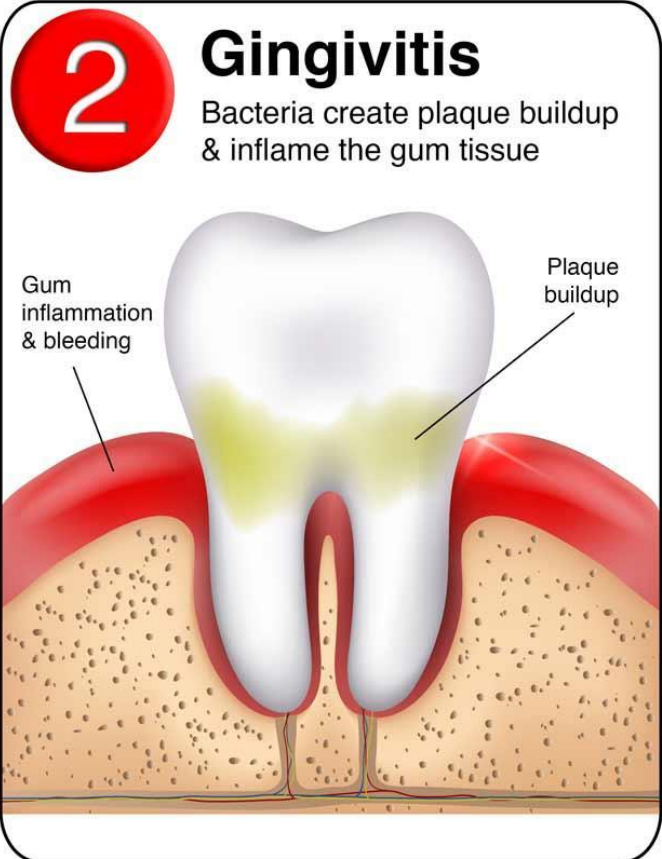
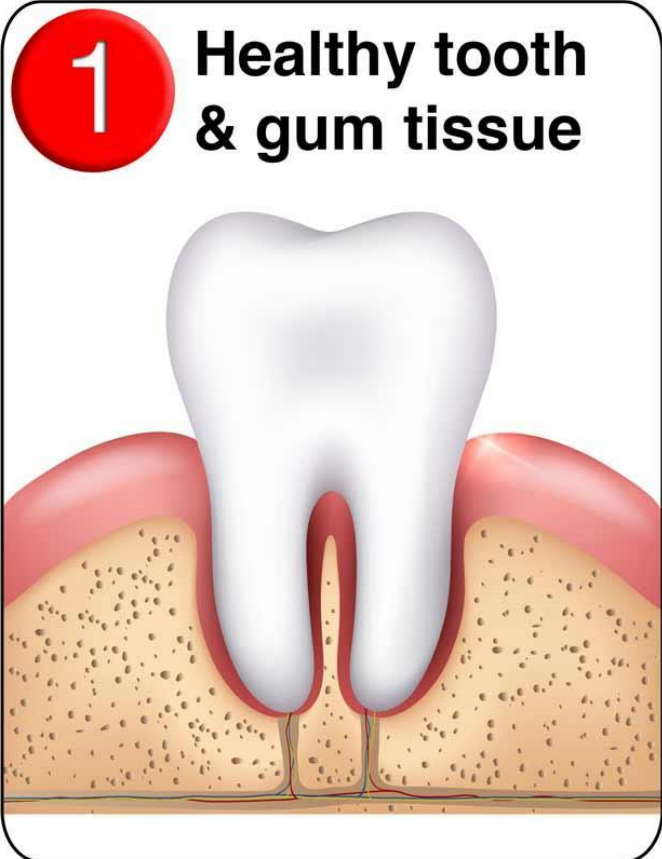
- Smoking causes inflammation and decreased immune function.

Is an infection of the gums and can affect the bone structure that supports your teeth , it can make your teeth fall out

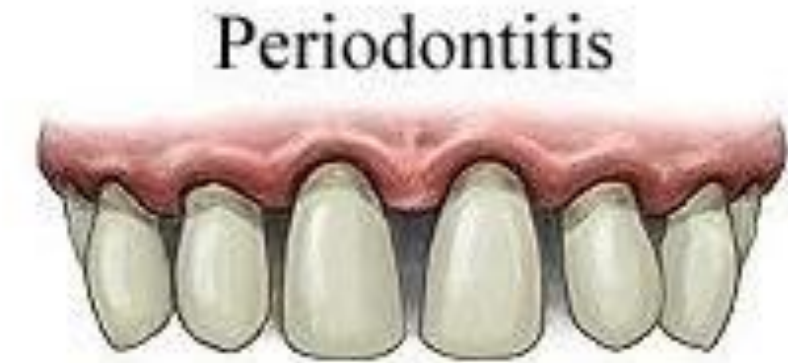


What Happens with Periodontal Disease?

- Red or swollen gums
- Tender or bleeding gums
- Painful chewing
- Loose teeth
- Sensitive teeth
- Gums that have pulled away from your teeth



Treatment of gum disease :

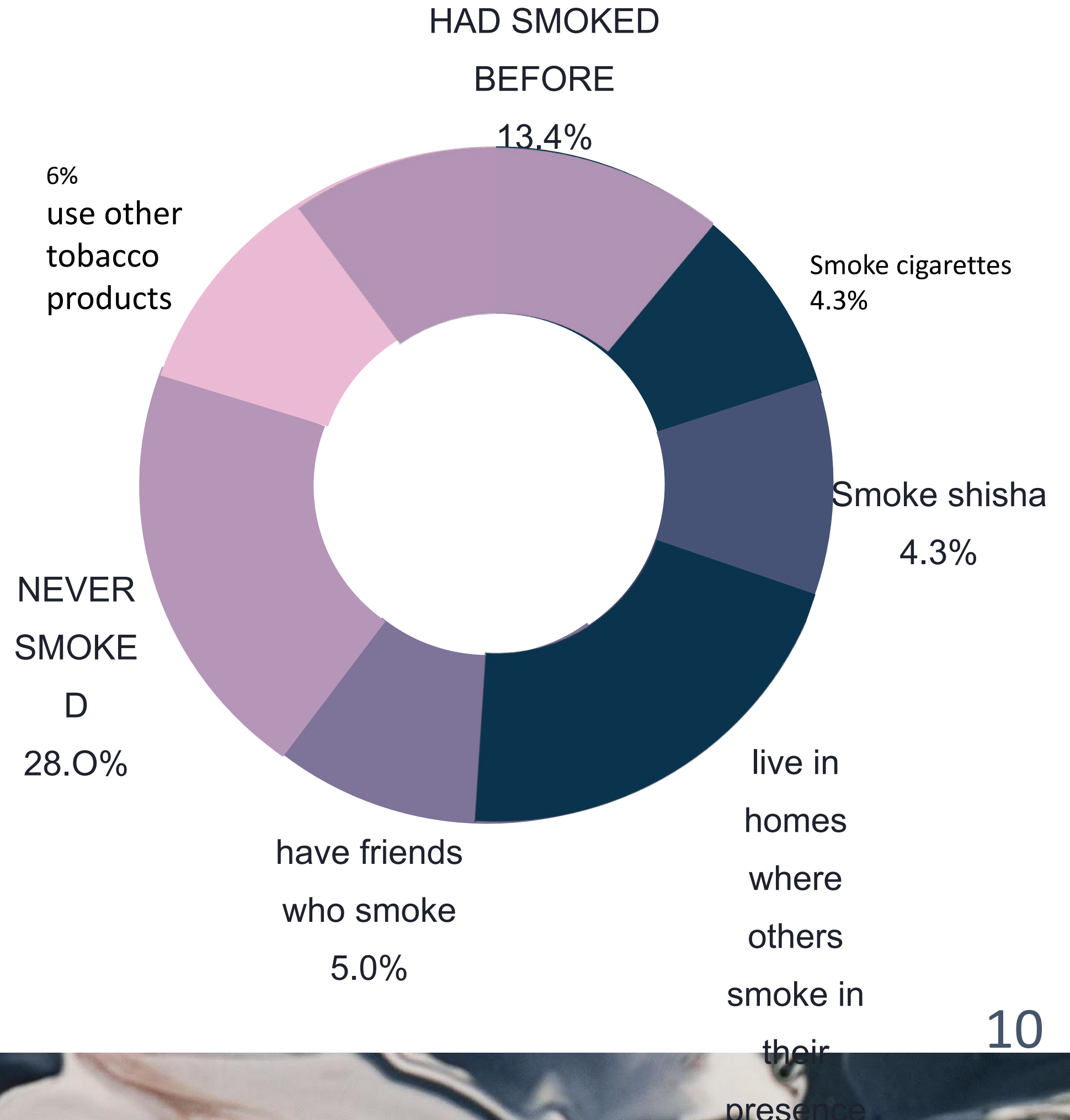
- Deep cleaning below the gum line.
- Prescription mouthwash or medication.
- Surgery to remove tartar deep within the gums.
- Surgery to help heal bone or gums lost to periodontitis.
